What We are doing a carriageway maintenance repair.

When The work is expected to start Monday 18th November 2024, expected completion is the 29th November 2024. (weather permitting).
Hours of work will be between 7am - 7pm. (week days)

Details

- There will be cones and construction vehicles while work is carried out. On-street parking will be **unavailable** in the construction areas.
- You will still have access to your property during the work period. However, a **daily road closure** will be operating between the hours 7am and 7pm. STMs will guide residents while the daily road closure is operating. There may be short delays during these hours and your understanding is appreciated.
- Please let us know if you have any specific requirements for property access i.e. for medical visits, home help, large vehicle deliveries/moving, or other planned work on your property.
- Residue from new surfaces, like asphalt and chipseal, can stick to your shoes or car tyres after the first few days of works being completed. Please be mindful of this when entering your garage or home. Please also be assured that we have been working with contractors to source new products that limit the chances of this occurring, and have already been trialling them across the wider Christchurch area.
- Surfaces may be uneven at times, but we will aim to minimise this.
- Work will be rescheduled if the weather is bad.
- There may be periods of noise and vibration, although we will aim to keep this to a minimum.

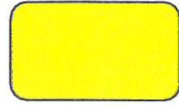

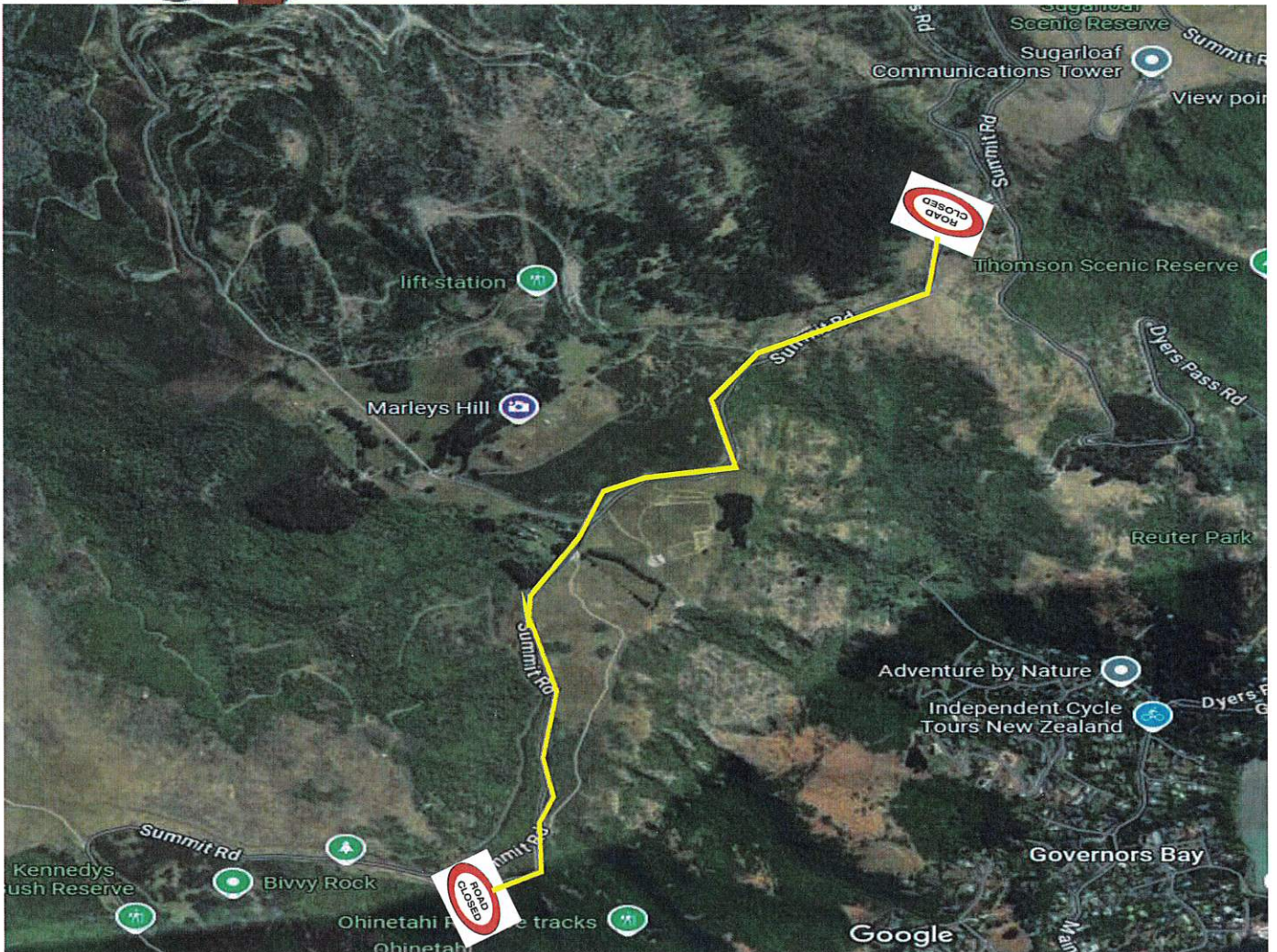
